TOWN OF HUACHUCA CITY ROADWAY INVENTORY AND ASSESSMENT

In partnership with the Town of Huachuca City, Cochise County and ADOT, a detailed roadway inventory and assessment was completed of the greater Huachuca City area. Traffic counts, pavement condition, need for transit stops, bicycle lanes and sidewalks were considered. Rick Engineering Company provided consultant services.

The data collection effort led to identification of prioritized transportation projects that could compete for state or regional construction funding. The Town's General Plan goal to complete a Major Streets & Scenic Route Plan was included in the Study's Final Report. Detailed utility maps for Water, Sewer, Gas and Communications were also provided in both electronic & hard-copy formats for the Town's Public Works Dept.

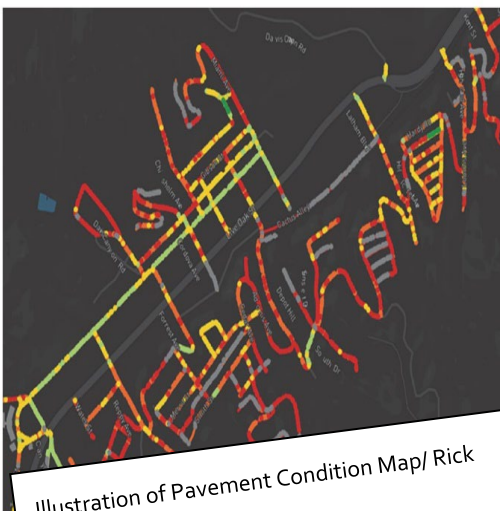


Illustration of Pavement Condition Map/ Rick Engineering

Roadway Inventory & Assessment Findings included recommendations for maintaining critical data, systematic drainage improvements, funding strategies, potential Town Roadway Design Standards adoption, , coordination between Town and County for shared transportation system concerns. Four prioritized projects were selected by Town Council: Skyline Drive; School Drive; Gila Avenue and Skyline Pathway. The Skyline Drive project was awarded design funds in the regional Transportation Improvement Program for Fiscal Year 2024. Design work is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2023.
